Year 12 Iceland Trip – Easter 2027 (4th-7th April 2027)

We are very excited to offer a unique opportunity for students during Easter 2027. While this is primarily aimed at Geography students, we are pleased to be able to offer the wider Sixth Form community this amazing enrichment experience.

The trip will be for 4 days/3 nights running in the second week of the Easter Holidays in 2027. The cost of the tour is estimated to cost **£1325-£1360** subject to numbers, which includes:

- Return flights from Heathrow Airport (Icelandair) or Luton Airport (easyJet)
- Airport transfer from the school to the airport
- Hold luggage for all passengers
- Professional local guide or Teacher Tour Leader (subject to availability) for all but the last day
- Students in multi-bedded rooms with bed linen and possible shared facilities
- Full board basis – from dinner on first day to breakfast on last day
- All transportation within Iceland including airport transfers
- Travel Disruption Support, protecting the group should the unexpected happen

Highlights on the trip will include:

- Reykjanes Peninsula
- Waterfalls – Seljalandsfoss, Skógafoss
- Sólheimajökull Glacier Walk
- Golden Circle – Secret Lagoon, Geysir, Gullfoss, Thingvellir National Park
- Hellisheidi Geothermal Power Station, Lava Show

The deadline for indicating a desire for your child to attend is **Friday 18th September 2026**. Your child will be notified later this month if they have been allocated a place on this trip and arrangements for outstanding instalments will be communicated.

Please note, that by accepting your child's place on this trip, you are undertaking to make full payment of the price indicated above. Please also note that Discover the World do not differ from other tour companies with regards to cancellations and cancellation fees will apply.

The school will follow all advice given by the Foreign and Commonwealth Office, Department for Education and our tour operators when it comes to overseas travel for school trips. The tours operators we use provide both ABTA and ATOL protection as part of our tour packages. In the event that the FCO advises “against all travel” to an area or region, then these policies provide protection to prevent any loss in case of necessary cancellation. The school holds travel insurance through the Department for Education Risk Protection Arrangement (RPA) which provides cover in case of travel disruption, medical issues and other emergencies. This insurance does not cover any personal items including money, phones, gadgets and clothing in case of loss, damage or theft. Should you decide to remove your son/daughter from any trip where travel is still advised then this will not be covered by insurance, ABTA or ATOL.

Participation in this trip is subject to good conduct in school prior to the trip taking place. If any student’s behaviour or attitude is in question and they are removed from the trip due to their conduct, any monies paid to date will not be refunded.
