Visit to Singapore and Anderson Junior College - 20th July to 28th July 2019 (Summer Holidays)

Sandringham has a partnership with Anderson Junior College, a prestigious Sixth Form in Singapore, established in 2016. Since Mr Gray's first visit in 2016, a group of students from Anderson Junior College visited Sandringham in 2017 and are due to return again in November 2018.

We are pleased to be able to offer up to 15 Sandringham students the opportunity to visit Singapore in July 2019. The visit will comprise of three days spent at Anderson Junior College, experiencing student life including lessons and enrichment activities. As the college specialises in science, we recommend that students opting to go on this trip study science or STEM A levels but students studying other subjects may also apply. The remaining days in Singapore will be spent sightseeing including the world famous Singapore Flyer, a cruise along the Singapore River and a visit to Gardens by the Bay, a futuristic nature park.

The approximate cost of the trip will be £1,535, including all attractions, accommodation, meals, coach transfers, a guide in Singapore and airport taxes. Families will be expected to drop their children to and from the airport in the UK. The final cost may vary slightly, depending on the exact flight prices when we book in September and the strength of the pound.

If you are interested in this fantastic opportunity to experience life as a student in Singapore and to explore this fascinating, culturally rich Asian city-state, please return the reply slip below and return to Dr Creaby by Wednesday 19th September. Should this trip be oversubscribed we will use a lottery system to allocate places.

Participation in this trip is subject to good conduct in school prior to the trip taking place. If any student's behaviour or attitude is in question and they are removed from the trip due to their conduct, any monies paid to date will not be refunded.
