Students will be provided with all breakfasts, lunches and evening meals. Occasionally, they may wish to purchase lunch in a restaurant in resort.

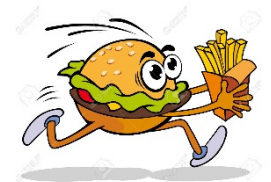
They will need a packed lunch to eat on the coach journey and we will be stopping for breakfast in Austria.

Kit List

Luggage allowance – soft luggage bag

To include:
