Literacy	Lexia Students with an English stanine score of 3 or less will be withdrawn from S4LL to focus on reading and comprehension. Those higher than 3 will be offered the use of Lexia for home use.	Improvements in students' reading fluency, comprehension and reading ages.	School SEND budget £1460 (for three years)
Literacy	Whole School Read: Copies of the whole school read will be purchased for each of the students so that they have immediate access to the novel. The audio book will also be available to support their reading and understanding.	Improvements in students' reading fluency and comprehension. Students have more active engagement in a school-wide literacy initiative.	Catch-up budget £181.60

<b>Literacy</b>	In class, guided reading unit for students in 7A5 and 7B5 to support with SAT skills on <i>Charlie and the Chocolate Factory</i> delivered by English subject specialists.	Improvements in students' reading and writing scores evident through a SATs progress test.	Catch-up budget £167.60
<b>Literacy</b>	Out of class reading buddies with year 12 students during Friday registration. Students will use a 'reading passport' to track reading progress and complete active reading tasks.	Improvements in students' reading skills and basic key skills to help them progress at KS3.	School budget
<b>Numeracy</b>	New 'Maths Framework Intervention' workbooks for students in set 5 and in Key Skills.	Improvements in students' understanding and skills to help them make progress at KS3.	School budget £599
<b>Numeracy</b>	Numicon for students in set 5.	Helps students bridge from concrete to abstract understanding in numeracy using more kinaesthetic activities. Helps students understand number operations. It is a 12-week programme which is delivered in normal lessons.	School budget £532
<b>Literacy &amp; Numeracy</b>	Cogmed Programme which works to improve students' working memory skills. Students complete 25 sessions of 40 minutes each. Students are withdrawn from S4LL to complete these.	Improvements in students' working memory.	School SEND budget £225
<b>Literacy &amp; Numeracy</b>	Timetabled Key Skills lessons (literacy and numeracy) to support students' transition between KS2 and 3 (lessons in place of MFL). Key skills are delivered by subject specialists who support the development of key skills such as phonics, number.	Improvements in students' English and maths outcomes	School budget
