ELECTION OF PARENT GOVERNOR

For the purpose of the election of a parent governor, a parent (including carers) of registered pupils at the school is:-

"Parent" is defined for the purposes of parent governor elections as including "any individual who has or has had parental responsibility for, or cares or has cared for, a child or young person under the age of 18". It includes a person who the child lives with or who looks after the child, irrespective of what their relationship is with the child. The reference in the definition must be someone involved in the full-time care of the child on a settled basis.' *Guide to the law, Chapter 3, paragraph 4.*
